Sedgefield Middle School UPDATES 2023-2024

Clothes must be worn as designed. Shorts should be a minimum of a 3 inch insegm. Clothes must be worn as designed. Shorts should be a minimum of a 3 inch inseam cannot be rolled up in the leg or at the waistband, pants must be worn at the waist. The core of the body includes the back. 2/3 of the back MUST be covered. Clothes MUST cover the core of the body while wearing a backpack or sitting in a chair. Clothing cannot slide down to reveal bottom while sitting or standing. Ski-masks or other face-coverings that cover more than the nose and mouth are not allowed at any time on campus.

Spartans are expected to dress appropriately each day for activities they are required to participate in, including labs, PE, etc. We ask students and parents to ensure clothing choices are respectful of school expectations and environment. If a Spartan is not in dress code a member of the Student Services team will document the incident and contact parents/quardians of student. A pattern of violations can result in a loss of privilege.

**CORE OF THE BODY IS BOTH** THE FRONT & BACK



Spartans should wear clothing that covers the core of their body. Shoes must be worn at all times on campus. Shoes cannot be bedroom slippers, athletic cleats, steel-toed, or designed in a way that limits activities.

Pants must be worn at the waist, covering undergarments. If wearing a separate bottom and top, both should be clearly visible. Tops should not be covering shorts. Stomachs and bottoms should not show.

Clothing must have fabric in the front, back and both sides with no space between the top and the bottom. Tops must have straps that cover undergarments. Clothing should not be transparent.

Hats, toboggans, headscarfs, bandanas, or other head gear can not be worn inside the building. Hoods on sweatshirts and jackets MUST be removed in the building. Ears MUST be visible at all times for safety. This does not apply to religious headpieces.

Clothing may not advertise, advocate, or depict---alcohol, tobacco, marijuana, other controlled substances, pornography, nudity, sexual acts, or content targeting a specific subgroup in a negative manner.
