Welcome and Call to Order

Principal Update

Sheena Miracle, Principal

- State of the School
- Ms. Charles' position has been filled. Ms. Dawson is expected to return in January 2024.
- There is a basketball game tonight. Administration has started a ticket lottery to help control the crowd size.
- SMS has acquired a grant from the Charlotte Hornets that will be used to repair the gym floor. Repairs should be completed before August 2024.
- All students except for those in Math 1 and Math 2 are using iReady for math support. Math 1 and Match 2 students have access to the Delta Math platform. Administration hopes to have Carnegie Tutors in place in January 2024.
- 67 students took the Math 1 benchmark assessment, only 1 did not show proficiency.
- Extended day tutoring starts in January for Math 1 students. A teacher is paid to stay after school to tutor students needing additional support.
- Results from the latest Benchmark Assessment show that the school is trending in an overall positive direction. The school is also seeing a correlation between proficiency and good attendance.
- Latest data measuring Growth shows that overall, the school is doing well.
- There is opportunity for improvement in science. Some of the questions included on the benchmark assessment had not been covered in class prior to the assessment. The 3rd science benchmark will be given in April.
- MAP tests are given at end of January. Those scores help predict EOG scores. Current plan is to help those students who are in the 90th and above percentile in science receive a science blitz to help this group exceed their already high goals and to show growth.
- Behavior update: the Administration is improving community and family engagement with a specific group of students/families. At risk students are struggling more this time of year.

- New digital hall pass system is designed to help monitor instructional time, frequency of bathroom visits, set parameters for when there is check out availability, how many students can be out of class at one time and can alert admin if a student has been gone an excessive amount of time.
- CMS has no new Chromebooks available. Refurbished high school Chromebooks may be available for middle school. Administration hopes to have working Chromebooks for all students in time for testing.
- Monitoring any changes to the number of Marie G. Davis and Pinewood students potentially moving to SMS. Any enrollment changes could potentially impact the SMS Title 1 designation and staffing levels.
- PTO would like to see a Drama elective offering. To potentially share a teacher with AG, the school enrollment would need to increase.
- Reminder to the PTO, Ms. Miracle will be traveling and in professional development during January.
- A suggestion was made to move the feeder school principal lunch to earlier in the year, October or early November timeframe.
- The application for the Lowe's Grant is moving forward and going well.
