Sedgefield Middle School 2023-2024 SMART Goals:

1. The percent of 8th grade students who score at the College and Career (CCR) level -- a 4 or 5 -- on the Grade 8 Mathematics EOG will increase from 5.3% in SY2021-22 to 16.7% in SY2022-23 and 28.0 % in SY2023-24. (A2.04, B3.03 and CMS Goal 2)
2. We will exceed expected Educator Value Added Assessment System (EVAAS) growth for our overall school index in SY2022-23 and SY2023-24. (A4.01, B3.03 and CMS Goal 4)
3. The percent of students reporting a positive self-perception of their self-management will increase from 72.0% on the Fall 2021 Panorama Screener (in Grades 6-12) to 77% in SY2022-23 and 82% in SY2023-24. (A4.16) (CMS Goal CMS Guardrail 3.1)
4. Out-of-School Suspension (OSS) disproportionately for Black students will decrease from 33.9% in SY2021-22 to 28.4% in SY2022-23 and 23.0% in SY2023-24. (E.1.06, A 1.07 and CMS Guardrail 1.3)

A 4.06- ALL teachers are attentive to students’ emotional states, guide students in managing their emotions, and arrange for supports and interventions.

1. Sedgefield Middle School will offer professional development on Panorama and Capturing Kids Hearts Curriculum. (SEL, EVAAS,FAMS-30)
CKH training on Monday, 11/6/23, and entire staff was trained in August, 2023. Part of culture.

B 3.03- The principal monitors curriculum and classroom instruction regularly.

1. Establish a walkthrough schedule on a monthly basis for the Instructional Leadership Team to go into the teacher's classroom with a feedback instrument. (8th Grade Math, EVAAS, FAMS-3) Relay coaching training alters walk through forms. Changes in expectations and structures. Schedule is delayed due to Relay training and changes in district. Move to January, 2024.
2. Develop a walkthrough form that is aligned with teacher evaluation instrument, school non-negotiable, district goals and guardrails, curriculum standards, Get Better Faster and Core Actions with feedback and suggestions. (8th Grade Math, EVAAS, Disproportionality,FAM-3) Relay training and changes in district. Move to January 2024.
